



## 2024 Nomination Package Curling Community Hero Award - Individual or Group

This award serves to recognize those who made an extraordinary contribution to the sport of curling and their community. As nominator, this is your opportunity to recognize the tireless contributor at your club who makes it a better place, always willing to lend a hand for the common good.

### Eligible Candidates

- Must be a member of a CurlON curling club/center (club in good standing) This individual or group can be a volunteer, administrator, ice technician, official, curler, instructor, coach, team.
- Involved in the promotion and development of community and/or charitable initiatives to help others, going beyond their regular day to day duties;
- Consistent and outstanding dedication to making their community a better place;
- Recognized as an individual or group of outstanding character.

### Ineligible Candidates

- Self-nominations will not be accepted

### Selection Process

CurlON's Nominations Committee will review all nominations put forward by the deadline. The committee will select a maximum of three award recipients annually. All candidates will be contacted by the Nominations Committee Chair by July 15th.

Recipient(s) will receive their Curling Community Hero Award at the Annual General Meeting in the fall of 2024.
